

**Town of Cornish
Selectmen's Meeting
June 11, 2014**

Dan Sherman and Emily Ward were present for the meeting.

May 28th meeting minutes, Payroll and Accounts Payable warrants reviewed and signed.

Selectman Sherman and Bob Sturgeon met with Ken Gardner and Norman Harding at Pike Memorial Hall June 6th to look at a system for water remediation at Pike Hall. Testing was done and we are awaiting Ken Gardner's report.

An individual driving a red Toyota Tacoma has been entering Thompson Park around 5:00 or 5:30 pm every night and filling containers (30-50 gallons) with water from the fountain spigot.

Outlying cemeteries will be a topic for the June 25th meeting. Selectman Ward will consult with Russell Bleakney ahead of the meeting.

Motion made that the H.A. Mapes, Inc. check disbursement agreed on in the May 28th meeting minutes take place according to our discussion. Seconded and approved.

Paul Anderson asks when and why did the Town stop maintaining his road (Anderson Drive) because during mud season this year the road was impassable. Paul stated the Town has plowed the road in the past. Selectman Sherman brought the question to the meeting and will talk with Bob Sturgeon.

Roland Scott will be asked to attend the June 18th workshop.

Fire Chief Pingree along with Gerry Day closed off Main Street while CAB volunteers painted the crosswalks and put down stripes in 3 designated "NO PARKING" areas; Krista's, easterly edge of Thompson Park and Bonney Memorial Library's side of Bridge Street. DOT will install signs within two weeks.

Selectmen reviewed the 4 resumes submitted for the Code Enforcement Officer position. Two applicants, Wes Sunderland and Steven Anthony, will be scheduled for interviews and reference checks.

Correspondence from Mike Edgecomb, Time Warner Cable contained an application to be completed by the Selectmen before June 30th. Selectman Ward offered to review and complete the application and send it back to Mike. Representatives Ron Collins and Jonathan Kinney letters of support will be included.

Fairpoint Communications has challenged some of the roads listed on the ConnectME Grant Pre-application. Fairpoint notified the town that DSL is available and infrastructure for Broadband in areas Cornish is requesting Time Warner to install their fiber. "True High Speed Internet" is not an option available to Fairpoint's customers though.

Selectman Ward will investigate the reported damage done to the kiosk in Thompson Park.
