Craig Jones, Steve Smith, Diann W. Perkins and Darrell Watson complained they didn't receive prior notification that the Intervale Road wouldn't be plowed and contractors hired by businesses are pushing the plowed snow down back onto McCubrey and Burnell Way. Selectmen and David Whitney will drive down and evaluate the areas. Craig Jones was asked to talk to business owners. Questions are to be submitted to the town office before the next meeting. The school district has already acknowledged the Town owns the Cornish Elementary bell. The School Board will vote on the Hilltop Baptist Church and MSAD55 sales agreement tonight. A document between Purchaser of Cornish Elementary and the Town clarifies that the bell, the Cornish Elementary sign, and support structures located in front of the building at 17 School Street has been given to the Town of Cornish by MSAD55. The bell and sign with the support structures will be moved from the property no later than June 2015. Motion made to accept and sign the document. Seconded and approved.

Motion made that Selectmen approve signing the Landlord Waiver drafted by Bangor Saving Bank for Heli Modified, Inc. provided the change indicating the Lender can only access Personal Property has been made to the document. Seconded and approved.

Abatements on Personal Property accounts discussed and approved at the 12/23/14 meeting were signed.
