

Medical Marijuana Ordinance
Meeting Minutes 03/01/16

Meeting called to order @ 07:00pm by Chairman MacMaster

Committee members present – Les MacMaster, Diann Perkins, Sarah Gormady, Mike Fulginiti, Dan Drake

Agenda Item 1 – Housekeeping/Membership

Les discussed self declaration. His thinking was that we should self-declare to the highest order. As Dan is both a Qualifying Patient and a Primary Caregiver, the thinking was that Dan should declare as a Primary Caregiver, thereby opening up a membership position for a Qualifying Patient. Dan agreed with the thinking and self-declared as a Primary Caregiver.

The committee now consists of two Primary Caregivers, one Qualifying Patient and three Concerned Citizens.

Current active members are Les MacMaster, Diann Perkins, Elijah Webber, Sarah Gormady, Dan Drake and Mike Fulginiti.

Les then welcomed four visitors from the community to the meeting and provided a brief background of our project.

Les then announced that all meeting minutes are now posted on the Town Website, www.cornishme.com, as well as scheduled meetings and committee members.

Agenda Item 2 – Continuing review of “Rules Governing the Maine Medical Use of Marijuana Program” [10-144 CMR Chapter 122, Effective Date: September 17, 2013](#)

We resumed our review of the current rules at Section 3, DEBILITATING MEDICAL CONDITIONS. We then reviewed several of the definitions used in this section, but as expected, there was little the committee felt it could add to this section.

We then reviewed Section 4, QUALIFYING PATIENT. The review also included PHYSICIAN’S WRITTEN CERTIFICATION, DESIGNATION FORM, PATIENT’S AUTHORIZED CONDUCT and PHYSICIAN’S AUTHORIZED CONDUCT.

Qualifying Patients may voluntarily register with the State but are not required to.

Again, the committee did not find the need to make adjustments to the rules set forth by the State.

We then reviewed Section 5, PRIMARY CAREGIVER. As part of the rules review, we also examined FOOD ESTABLISHMENT LICENSE and PRIMARY CAREGIVERS AUTHORIZED CONDUCT.

Primary Caregivers are required (with few exceptions) to register with the State.

We shall continue at Section 6 REGISTERED DISPENSARIES at the next meeting, scheduled for Tues Mar 15 at 7:00pm at Pike Hall.
