

TOWN OF CORNISH
SELECTMEN BUSINESS MEETING
MARCH 15, 2017

Emily Ward and Mathieu Cama were present for the Business Meeting.

The Selectmen met with CEO (Code Enforcement Officer) Wes Sunderland about contacting MMA (Maine Municipal Association). The Selectmen asked that any communication via phone be followed with an email for documentation. The Selectmen asked Wes to investigate the blocked fire exits at Stoneridge Motel following an email sent to Wes on February 15, 2017, and the debris on the abandoned River Rd. The property on North Rd, belonging to Linda Corbin, was also discussed. The Selectmen advised that Wes redrafted his letter to Ms. Corbin stating that she will need to go before the Planning Board, if there is a plan to divide the property into more than two (2) single occupancy lots.

Accounts payable, payroll warrants and March 1, 2017 meeting minutes were approved and signed.

Two ARF's (Action Request Forms) were received from Stephen Hartford. The first addressed the wording of the absentee ballot applications for the upcoming Municipal Election. Kaye copied the absentee ballot application from last November's Federal election. She will contact Mr. Hartford. The second ARF was a concern to have Old Pike Rd posted. Mat will forward the request to Road Commissioner Bob Sturgeon.

The Selectmen received a letter from the Town of Hollis, thanking the Cornish Volunteer Fire Department for their "exceptional timely and professional manner" in response to a structure fire. The Selectmen would also like to say job well done to our Firemen.

Mat provided an update about the ACO's (Animal Control Officers) concerns about horses being mistreated at Tracey Lane. Former ACO Heather Ricker visited the location when ACO Richard Guilbault was unavailable. Mat talked to Richard earlier today and stated that the owner had removed the horses. The Selectmen will pass on to Richard that Heather needs to be appointed to be backup for Richard.

Mat would like to formally thank Emily for everything she has done for the Town of Cornish in the past three years.
