SELECTMEN BUSINESS MEETING

JULY 5, 2017

Daniel Sherman, Mathieu Cama, and Carlton Candage were present for the business meeting.

The Selectmen met with Assessor Ben Thompson and Emily Ward to discuss assessing needs for the remainder of Peter Pawlowski's contract.

Motion to enter Executive Session pursuant to M.R.S.A. § 405 (6) (A) to discuss a personnel matter at 4:45 PM. Seconded, all in favor.

The selectmen returned to regular session at 5:07 PM.

RHR Smith Audit review, the Selectmen would like more time to look over the audit draft, it will be added to next weeks agenda.

ARF (Action Request Form) was received from Peter Zack about the Francis Small Heritage Trust. Carlton will look into the matter.

Cornish Inn liquor license was submitted for renewal. Motion to approve the liquor license, seconded, all in favor.

The York County Budget Committee has requested the Selectmen's support against a new court house which would be located in Biddeford. Motion to support York County and sign the letter. Seconded, all in favor.

Eagle Mill Park, waiting for a letter from the committee detailing what they would like to do at the park.

Town Building Use Request was received from the Sacopee Valley Adult Education class. They would like to use the Fire Station in September. Motion to approve the request. Seconded, all in favor.

Town Building Use Request was received from Scott and Mary Pingree to use the Fire Station on July 23, 2017. Motion to approve request. Seconded, all in favor.

ARF status of Ms. Eastman's request about rocks in Little River. Motion to have CEO Wes Sunderland contact DEP for clarification on the obstruction of water ways. Seconded, all in favor.
