Howard Saturley interior lighted sign request. Has no permit and refused the conditional use permit granted by last meeting of the board. Resolved to send notice of violation on lack of permit. Also noted that the back of his new construction is over the highway right of way. Suggested that whereas it would be very expensive to correct the construction, the town would not enforce this issue, if he would cooperate and not install an interior lighted sign, and put shielding in to reduce glare of his existing island lighting. So Voted All.

Resolved to send notice of violation to C.N. Brown Co. on set-back violation on their underground tanks and violation of "glare standard" on their new sign. So Voted All.

R. Arendt on Article 47 of 1982 town warrant; The article was not properly worded and therefore not binding on town to elect the Board Members. As article now stands, it is only advisory to town, not law. Appointed members would have to fill out their respective terms. Professional opinion is that elected boards work poorly, and frequently reflect the interests of single interest pressure groups.

Ordered 150 new building code ordinances (yellow) with the changes voted on previously. Additional change on mobile home roofs not to exceed 12'6" high; so that they could be moved if owner wanted to do so (recommended by Schavi Mobile Homes). So Voted All

(1) Article For Town Warrant: "Shall the Town vote to adopt the Cornish Building Code of 1983.) Planning Board Recommends Yes.

(2) Article for Town Warrant: "Shall the town vote to pay members of the board ten dollars, (\$10.00), for each meeting attended." Planning Board recommends Yes. So Voted All.
