A special meeting of the planning board was held at Ray Wallace's on October 2, 1972

The purpose of this meeting was discuss the pending sale of a piece of land by James Seelye. There was discussion as to whether this would constitute a subdivision when coupled with previous sales of land by Mr. Seelye. It was concluded that this sale would not constitute a subdivision because previous sales were from separate parcels of land with separate deeds. Also, some of these transactions took place before the subdivision law was instituted.

The board voted unanimously to approve Mr. Seelye's sale with the reservation that he would inform the board before any further transactions.
