Motion: To send letter to James Seelye in response to his recent request for Planning Board approval of his conditional use permit to renovate the grange hall. Motion carried unapposed with Mr. Taylor not voting, to send letter as drafted. (see attached letter)

Discussion: Request of Mr. and Mrs. Fosco Picchi to have a smallbusiness in their home, using less than 10% of the home floor space. Upon inspection, all regulations have been complied with, and they are in compliance based upon the intended use. Also noted: Mr. & Mrs. Picchi produced letters from neighbors expressing no opposition. Also noted: Any deviation from presented plans would be considered beyond the scope of existing ordinances. Receipt of a copy of these minutes is all that is needed to proceed with the Picchi's plans.
