Killdeer Acres was represented by their lawyer, Barbra Conover. She asked where the project was at this time. Marilyn stated that the board is tableing Killdeer Acres, the reason being that doing the research on the deeds it seems that this may be an illegal subdivision at this time resulting from the sale of property. (See Attached ^{Sheet A} list). This information will be pass on to the selectmen and they will decide what course of action to take. Mrs. Conover was allowed to copy our copies of the deeds.

Patten Corp. D. e. P. required them to put the buffer zone on the map. Mr. Boyle presented us with the letters he received from the School, Fire Dep., Police Dep., and the Post Office. The only discussion was on the letter from the Sup. of Schools. It stated that the Cornish School is close to it ~~capacity~~, Mr. Boyle feels that the type of people who buy thier lots will not have that much of an effect on the schools. We stated that the Schools are a major concern for this area and the question of development. He asked if he ~~completed~~ some information on thier clients would we listen to it. We agreed to do this.

The road construction was discussed. See attached sheet **B** for required road specs. passed.

Mr. Boyle stated that they are thinking that they would not put in ullities. Marilyn stated she would look into this matter and she is also waiting for information from C.M.P. befor we make a decision.
