

The June 20th meeting of the planning board was quite brief. Rodney Sta was on hand to have me help answer some questions presented to him by the C.D.C. and to get approval for power from Central Maine Power. Mr. Wallace received two requests for sub-division standards. One was from the Veirick Realty Trust of Ancober, and the other from U.S. Dept. of Agriculture and F.H.A. which he requested new housing starts in Cornish.

Ms. Wallace indicated that William Liberty, the building inspector and selectment would attend the July meeting to discuss procedures for building approval.

Mr. Pike stated that as of June meeting there had been no questions involving the sub-division and building approval notice set out with the 1972 tax bills.

There are however several build starts at this time that may be questioned by the board in the future.
