Monday, July 18, 2016 WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES

Call Meeting to Order: 6:45 PM by John Morrissey

New Business:

1. Bonney Memorial Library renovation

- a. Jack Bash and Scott Cecil gave an overview of the plan to install solar panels on the roof of the Bonney Memorial Library.
 - i. Ken Hall recused himself because of a conflict of interest.
 - ii. Highlights of the plan:
 - 1. An array of low-profile solar panels would be added to the roof (a mock-up of a panel was exhibited).
 - 2. The panels would provide a source of clean energy and fit into the plan well, along with heat pumps, the removal of a furnace, energy-efficient windows, and LED lighting.
 - 3. An option for a solar farm and net-metering and the cost of transmitting the energy was discussed.
 - a. Scott Cecil: "A second option, perhaps in combination with panels on the library roof, or perhaps instead of panels on the library roof, would be to create a solar farm, also known as a community solar farm. We have a land home owner who has offered us space on his land for this. This would involve creating a contract between the library and the home/landowner to create an organization that would legally own the solar panel array. The array would be ground mounted on his property, facing south. I believe it would not be visible from any public road. The legal association would then contract with CMP to a net-billing arrangement (I spoke to Nate Pelletier at CMP to confirm that despite the failure of LD1649 to pass over the governor's veto that CMP is still entering into net-billing contracts under the existing rules.)"
 - 4. The Land Use Ordinance has restrictions on altering the roof line in the Historic District; it would depend on the degree of alteration and what effect the alteration would on the visibility of the panels. How visible would it be from Krista's, Thompson Park?
 - 5. Thanks to Diann W. Perkins for her assistance with the notes.
 - 6. <u>A site walk</u> was scheduled to Bonney Memorial Library for the <u>August 15, 2016</u> workshop meeting at 7:00 PM.

2. Work on social club language

- a. The Land Use Ordinance (LUO) only references "clubs" on page 22 Table 1, Table of Permissible Uses: EDUCATION, INSTITUTIONAL, PUBLIC. Clubs are given as requiring Conditional in the VC, HD, CD, RR and are prohibited in the IP, RD, RP, SD, and AP.
- b. The Planning board suggests that the LUO be amended to clearly define clubs.
 - i. Definition of a <u>club</u>: An association or organization dedicated to a certain interest or activity.
 - ii. Definition of a <u>social club</u>: A group of people or the place where they meet, generally formed around a common interest, occupation, or activity.

- iii. Such clubs and/or social clubs are welcome within the Town of Cornish, however, are prohibited from the districts of the Village Center and the Historic District.
