

A special meeting of the Cornish Planning Board was called July ~~7~~³ 1973 at the New Lincoln Hotel to discuss the definition of seasonal homes.

It was decided that the building code shall state the def. of seasonal home, subject to the vote of the town. The def shall read; Any home being built not being claimed as legal residence is a seasonal home.

It was also agreed that the building inspector should mark all permits for such buildings a seasonal homes rather than cottage, camp, etc. There will also be a set of guidelines to be handed out with all permits ~~or~~ regarding foundations.

The next meeting will be held July 10 at which a loitering ordinance will be discussed.
