

The September 20th meeting of the Cornish Planning Board was held at the town hall with Robert E. representing the board of selectmen.

Mr Wallace showed the members a form from the state requiring homeowners to register for waste waste disposal.

There was further discussion concerning the present system of issuing building and power permits. The Board felt that there should be a chronological order for approval of site location, perculation tests, building permits and power permits. One of the primary reasons for this was that the board would be aware of proposed construction before any permits are issued for any construction. It was decided that the board would present a new proposal at its next meeting with the board of selectmen.

It was suggested by the board and Mr. E. concurred that the members should be sworn in as

town officers at the next meeting.
The purpose of this is to protect
individual board members from lia-
suits for actions taken by the board.
Mr. Pike stated that the mem-
ber would be sworn in at the next
meeting.
