

**SELECTMEN'S MEETING
JANUARY 7, 2004**

The accounts payable and the payroll warrants were signed. The last meeting was cancelled due to the holidays so there were no minutes.

Peggi mentioned that excavation work was being done at the new fire station site. The land swap still needs to be straightened out, but Sylvia Pease said work could be started.

There was a meeting schedule discussion. The meeting about the Merc litigation was postponed until Jan. 15th. Peggi will go if someone will go with her. Vinal and John will check their schedules. There is a school district meeting on Mon the 12th. The budget meeting is on the 13th. There is also a meeting with John Cleveland and the Eddy's at Heli modified on the 16th at 9:30.

John brought up the fact that the Maine flag that is in front of Pike Hall needs to be replaced. He also discussed a GA case that he had worked on. He said that he is going to be in Florida at time of the next meeting.

Diane had done a report that shows about 20% of 2003 taxes are uncollected. She had some abatements and a supplement that needed to be signed, and a paper making her the agent for Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. Diane also mentioned that she had received a phone call from David Whitney about people parking on the road during snowstorms. She typed a letter to be distributed as needed, and had gone to speak to some people stating that their cars would be towed if they are left in the way.

The selectmen had a discussion about the dedication of the town report. They decided that they would dedicate it to two people; Martha Nee and Pauline Evans were picked for this honor.


