

MINUTES OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING - JAN. 21, 1991

PRESENT; W. NEAL, V. PENDEXTER, T. CARPER.

1. LIQUOR HEARING - ENTERPRISE REST. NO OPPOSITION. MOTION MADE AND SECONDED TO GRANT LICENSE TO GENEVA NOYES, D/B/A/ ENTERPRISE REST. VOTE 3-0.
2. MERC CONTRACT MATTER. MR. CAMPBELL AND MR. HERMATIC HERE TO DISCUSS THIS CONTRACT. THEY WILL ATTEND THE SPECIAL TOWN MEETING TO BE HELD JANUARY 23, 1991, AND WILL HAVE HAND-OUTS FOR THE TOWN MEETING. THE COST PER TON WILL BE \$47.00 PER TON ^{for 17 year and a} 17 YEAR CONTRACT BUT CAN BE TERMINATED JUNE 1, 1993. CAN CANCEL AFTER THREE YEARS, BY GIVING MERC A ONE YEAR NOTICE. RICHARD ERB, TOWN MANAGER OF KENNEBUNK AND F. GENT WILL ALSO BE AT THE TOWN MEETING. AFTER THIS IS APPROVED BY THE TOWNSPEOPLE, THE CONTRACT WILL BE SIGNED, FEB. 5, 1991, KEY PLAZA, PORTLAND.
