

MINUTES OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING - January 25, 1987

1) Stephen DiBiasco asked to come before the board and talk about the lights that he has requested be installed by the Town.

a) Race Trace - There is a lot of traffic in the area, going to barns, Vets office and the Flower Wagon will be moving into the Expo Hall shortly.

b) Pound Hill Road would only affect three families. Some of the residents expressed the feelings that they did not want a light there.

6) David Whitney has paid all his taxes.

7) Leak in Bathroom - Horace Perry has promised that he would repair it on Saturday.

8) complaint of dog in Jim's apartment. Blue Tick - Jim will speak to tenants.

9) Planning Board - they meet the same time as Selectmen. The Selectmen should set the time and they should abide by it. Planning Board under control of Selectmen. There is nothing to stop them from changing the date. Minutes of Meetings should go to Selectmen and building Inspector.
