

Selectmen's Meeting January 27, 2010

Vinal Pendexter, Nancy Perkins and Peggi Aspinall were present for the meeting.

Peter Houston introduced himself and gave an overview of the 2010 Census this Spring. He is the recruiter for this area and will be doing weekly testing of candidates. Workers must be 18 years or older and be willing to work a 40 hour week. Workers will make \$14.50/hour plus .50 cents a mile and make an 8-week commitment.

The High Road Reconstruction Project was reviewed in light of the complaints made at the recent Informational Meeting. Robert Sturgeon and the Selectmen troubleshot ideas for possible solutions to the placement of the sidewalk (right or left side of street), telephone pole locations, and trees impacted. Robert will meet with the engineering firm to shed some light on what is actually feasible. Robert will meet with the selectmen afterwards and a second meeting with the residents will be scheduled.

Warrants and minutes reviewed and signed.

Cornish School Alumni requests use of the Fire Station on 2/9 for a meeting, 4/24 and 5/22 to hold bean suppers, and 8/14 for their Annual Meeting. Motion made to approve the 2/9, 4/24, and 5/22 dates. Additional details are needed on the Cornish Alumni Annual Meeting before selectmen make a decision. Seconded and approved

Selectmen and Heli Modified, Inc. signed the new lease agreement for 2010 through 2012 with agreement that April through December of 2010, 2011 and 2012 to be negotiated in March.

Selectmen scheduled a workshop for 1/31/10 to review Planning Board By Laws and Fee Schedules for Planning Board and Code Enforcement Officer.

Abatement letters signed for Lisa Pease and Jane Vaillancourt.

Motion made to use ADA Account funds to copy and bind the Grant application packets. Seconded and approved.

Motion made to use ADA Account funds to pay the Grant Writer. Seconded and approved.

Vinal reports the Riverside Cemetery land may be able to close in the next few weeks. The surveyor has to finish work at the Martin's property this week. All Title searches have been completed.



The Trash Removal Contract will also go out to bid on May 1st.


Maine Municipal & Outreach Count of People Who Are Homeless was completed at the meeting for Maine State Housing Authority's Scott Tibbitts.

Seconded and approved.


Motion made to adjourn. Seconded and approved.
