Present: John Seelye, Dr. DiBiaso, Don Jack


1. No representative from the Enterprise here for the liquor license.
2. Two gun permits signed. Need definite reason for obtaining one.
3. 27 members of a group of concerned citizens met with the selectmen to discuss the alleged violations of John Seelye, in building at the Grange Hall. For a more detailed description of meeting, please see tape recorded at meeting.
4. Carroll Perkins is repairing the curtain.
5. Cornish Water Co. article done. Bud Runyon found an ambiguous statement in the beginning - is the Town of Cornish or the Water District purchasing the Water Co. Emergency Clause: Ray Hammond suggested that we use it.
6. Mike Hartford's road is breaking up. School bus drives up and turns around.
7. Solid Waste \$1730 plus \$900. Budget \$23,400 for 1986. Don has sent out five letters. Adopt flow ordinance, Don will bring this up to Planning Board.
8. Balance in Town Hall Fed. Revenue Sharing Account \$1,423.89. Rug in downstairs hall. Finish upstairs at later date. Need fans to circulate air in Hall.
