The State Planning office and State Fire Marshall office are attempting to create a building code that everyone in the state has to use. They are going to create a new State employee position of Code Trainer, which of it's self is not a problem because Rob Millard is already certified but, a State level Technical Building Codes Board will administer the code. They are taking the power away from the town and Nancy is unsure of how it's going to work.

Nancy asked for the status of the propane heater for the offices. Vinal will speak to Steve Barton.

A copy of the appeal submitted by Roland Scott that was filed after the stated deadline was reviewed by the selectmen. No action to be taken by the selectmen.
