Items discussed:

- 1) Copier - instruct Charlene not to purchase toner, etc.
- 2) Appointment for abatements with County Commissioners. They would like to meet Monday or Saturday during daylight hours. January 12th at 2:30 p.m. at Town Hall. Warren to call and confirm.
- 3) Update maps - it was voted at Town Meeting to revised the town Tax maps. Warren to call O'Donnell's.
- 4) Garv Hamlin wanted to know how his taxes are figured.
- 5) Llovd Sargent - Jim will contact him again in regard to a heater in lobby.
- 6) Update on storm windows - Wayne Mills ordered them in December and it takes 4-6 weeks.
- 7) David Whitnev has paid his taxes, all except one piece which was high, so he wants it taxed as personal property.
- 8) Letter received on Water Company - Vinal called Wilfred Taylor and asked for a meeting with Water Trustees. Vinal doesn't know where the matter stands. Warren feels if it, the Water purchase, hadn't passed by 12/31. it just won't happen.
- 9) Deed for Eva Lord property. Gordon Hall wants a Warranty Deed and the Town gave Quitclaim Deed. Elmer Runvon to be contacted and asked about proceeding to clear title so a Warranty Deed can be given.

- 14) Dump - Sebago Technics called and came today (1-5-87) and started preliminary survey. No contract from BIF as yet.

- 17) Ray Estabrook wants a chance to bid for printing of the Town Report if we are going to put it out for bids. Ray works for Seavey Printers.
- 18) Enterprise Liquor Hearing - January 19, 1987, put in Shoppers Guide.
- 19) Budget Meeting January 26 in Town Hall.
