

Jan. 6, 1976

Regular meeting on above date - all members present.

Discussion about parking at LGA lot on Sunday during church services at Town Hall. Those responsible should be made aware it is not a town parking lot and make their own arrangements for parking there.

Voted to ask the selectmen of the five towns to meet and discuss the following:

The cost of waste disposable at a figure agreeable both to the towns and Mr. Normantis.

A place to hold a rabies clinic in one ^{town} for all citizens of the five towns - some town other than Cornish should sponsor it this year.

Problem of what amount should be abated to taxpayers losing property by fire during the tax year.

It was noted that cars are still being parked on sidewalk in front of Candage and Carpenter homes.

Suggestion that a gun tranquilizer be purchased for picking up dogs and ask David Elliott to see how Porter and Parsonsfield would feel about the three towns buying one together.

Voted to ask Dick Blanchard to meet with Selectmen in two weeks at next regular meeting to discuss revaluation of town to bring the percentage up nearer state valuation.

Voted to ask David Elliott if he would take an inventory of dogs in town - cost of same from \$100 to \$125.

Underwriters Insurance has cancelled Municipal Officers Liability insurance and is not renewing. Another form is being sent with instructions where it can be purchased.
