

Selectmen's Meeting January 9, 2013

Vinal Pendexter and Nancy Perkins and Dan Sherman were present.

Minutes and Warrants reviewed and signed.

Mr. A. Duplessis wrote (10/3/12) to question why Riverfront Drive is not plowed, as it's a town road. Selectmen investigated the road's status, did a site walk, and David Whitney spoke with Mr. Duplessis about plowing concerns. Road Commissioner to be asked for evaluation of the road's condition and work needed.

Brent Anderson requests permission to purchase sand/salt mix from the town. Motion made to allow Brent Anderson to purchase sand/salt mix at \$20/ton from the town. Seconded and approved. *May Agenda item to revisit the practice of allowing purchase of sand/salt mix for commercial use.

Jennifer Otenti of 21 Wood Lane asked to be appointed to the Recycling Committee and Saco River Corridor Commission Board. She will be invited to the next meeting of the selectmen.

Complaint received of a snow bank obstructing view at Bridge Street and Route 25 by Bonney Memorial Library. Nancy will discuss with Dave Whitney and invite Jack Wadsworth.

Calista Cross approached Cornish Association of Businesses (CAB) to sponsor the Veterans Memorial Project under their 501C3.

Dan Sherman and Mathieu Cama met to discuss his qualifications for the Cornish EMA Director position. Motion made to appoint Mathieu Cama as EMA Director for Cornish. Seconded and approved.

Dan will email the Code Enforcement Officer to notify Mr. Harrisburg in writing that the quantity of unregistered trailers on his property is unacceptable.

Teri Ann Holden of CDBG approved use of town CDBG funds for economic development in the amount of \$7,000 anticipating a potential increase in jobs from Contour 360's building expansion. Vinal will meet with John Moller of Contour 360 and finalize the details.


Selectmen approved a draft letter of determination for Bonney Memorial Library Board's request for abatement of real estate tax.
