The letter was signed for Dennis Mowery's audit conclusion.


There was a discussion on the price increase from Animal Refuge League for the year 2002.


Paradigm Arts submitted a request for the use of the Pike Hall for rehearsals and dance program. Vinal thought more information was needed. Carlton will call her.

Carlton brought up a discussion about getting the Town Hall cleaned. He hired Keith Tibbets to clean for \$7.00 per hour.


Vinal has George Carroll's application for open space tax rate. Vinal will bring the information for the next meeting to decide the tax rate.
