

## Selectmen's Meeting October 10, 2007

Vinal Pendexter and Nancy Perkins were present for the meeting.

Fire Chief Scott Pingree discussed the EMA Director's actions regarding a lost pager replacement. Scott will get the pager back from him as he's moved to Limington.

Scott Pingree asked to have funds from renting the fire barn put into their maintenance account to cover cleaning supplies. Selectmen agreed.

Vinal toured the Ossipee Mountain radio site with Sam Gilpatrick. Scott explained that due to politics the Town doesn't have a backup site in the event of an outage. A discussion of possible options followed.

Warrants for payroll and accounts payable along with minutes from the September 26<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Cornish PTC was approved to use Pike Hall for their annual craft fair on December 1<sup>st</sup>. Selectmen asked that we make a suggestion that a donation toward heat would be appreciated.

Girl Scout Leaders meeting for November 14<sup>th</sup> from 6-7pm at the fire barn was approved.

Jerry Watson's request was approved for use of 3 tables and 20 chairs for Thanksgiving Day.

An 801 form for personal property reimbursement submitted by W.L. Sturgeon was signed.

Jobs for Maine Graduates program requested funds for recycling bins at MSAD55. Selectmen declined the request and suggested fundraising alternatives for the group to pursue.

Advertising for a General Assistance Public Meeting on October 24<sup>th</sup> meeting was approved.

Diane worked with Trio and produced the quarterly figures report and will convert to an Excel spreadsheet format for Nancy's review.

Current fund balance in CDBG account is \$164,000. Nancy asked if Heli Modified's proposed expansion would be funded from that account or if grants would be used. Vinal didn't think that 100% would be, but any grant would require matching funds.

U.S. Census Bureau's 2010 census request for town's participation was declined by the selectmen.

Vinal spoke with Mike Rogers about the decision of the York County Commissioners regarding George Carroll. Mr. Rogers' advice was to not do anything. In the event that Mr. Carroll chooses to appeal the case to the Superior Court, let him hire his own lawyer and the town would have to hire a lawyer at that time.


**Selectmen's Meeting


Vinal suggested that we investigate the costs of installing a fire alarm system for the Town Offices in time for the 2008 Town Warrant.
