

MINUTES OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING - October 12, 1987

Present: W. Neal; B. Ouellette; R. Othuse.

Executive Session was held re Town Assistance for rent payment.

- 1) Sewer Project: D. Harrington, C. Dunne, L. Ellis, M. Lyle and J. Stewart all eligible. Contact engineer and start projects.
- 2) Dump: Ronnie reported a good meeting. Luidas was in with a very good proposal. He will handle the Transfer Station at his lot. Open top trailers. Some tires and some wood. No large stumps. He will clean up present dump. Sign a contract for a fixed price for 5 year period - 10% differential. \$11,000 from each town put in escrow. Porter is against it (personality conflict) Parsonsfield interested, Baldwin interested, Cornish - Ronnie is for this. Requires a vote from each town. Operational 6 mos. They are still checking on Gilpatrick land. Normantus has all permits, they need to be updated, but he is ready to operation. Decision to be made October 21, 1987. The Selectmen of Cornish agree it is a good proposal. Majority vote rules and all five towns go along with it.
- 3) Sidewalks: R. Sturgeon suggests crushed rock. Start by Maxine Lyle's and Lis Mannings. Bonnie to take care of matter and get as much done for \$2,000 as she can.
- 4) Eva Lord Property: Eva had wood piled in barn. Ethel Sargent has a note signed by Eva stating that on her death Ethel could have the wood. Jim Seelye estimated \$300 was the cost of the wood. Ethel thought it was too much and wood was hers anyway. Ethel called a week ago and now wants the wood. Jim told her that she'd never get the wood. If Ethel has a document from Eva, then Ethel should have the wood. Ronnie and Bonnie agree, the town should purchase wood and give it to Ethel. MOTION: Ask Ethel for the document and the amount of wood and see that she gets it. Seconded. VOTE. Warren to contact Ethel.
- 5) Quit-Claim Deed never issued to Franklin Sanborn. Call Debbie for description.
- 6) Election November 3rd. Warrant to be signed.
- 7) Bonnie had several questions for David Birchfield in regards to Board of Appeals decision and CODE actions.
