equipment over it. Hoxie wants to contact them to see  
if they will take responsibility to fix it.  
The road is no longer a town road; but as soon as the  
town spends any money on it, it will become a town road  
again. It was suggested that Gordon to do the work  
himself and submit a bill as janitor.

IV. Adelaide Scribner  
Ronnie went to see her and she needs replacement of  
some pipes, flooring, roof, windows, and insulation
