

MINUTES SELECTMEN'S MEETING

October 20, 1986

Present: Warren Neal, John Seelye

Items discussed:

- 1) Letter read from Paul Frinsco re Water Company. Survey has been done. Copy is attached.
- 2) Sidewalks - Jim feels we should go ahead because of snow. To do Cumberland Street and in front of Church if any left.
- 3) Stephen reported that they were breaking up the Sidewalk at Saturley's.
- 4) Town Meeting, Fred Bechard/Maurice Ouelette Moderator. What do the Selectmen recommend? There is a question about other Towns legally purchasing land in Cornish (Old dump site). Maine Municipal reports it is perfectly legal. Recommend \$8,000 be appropriated for our share of what each town will be expected to contribute toward the dump.
- 6) Deed on land on Route 5. MAINE Municipal advised not to give a Warranty Deed unless the land was given as a gift to the Town. The town paid \$25 for the land around 1900. W. Taylor to do survey (Sanborns to pay) around the end of November. Then a Warranty Deed can be issued by an Attorney.
- 7) Parking on Sidewalks. County Attorney advises to call State Police.
- 8) Service contract for copier signed for 1 yr.
- 9) Concerned Citizens meeting in Town Hall. What should they pay? Actual cost as opposed to flate charge?
- 10) Richard Taylor would like an abatement of his taxes. (Reduce the value of the trailer) tabled--
