

## **Selectmen's Meeting October 25, 2006**

Vinal Pendexter, John Palmer, and Peggi Aspinall were present for the meeting.

Mark Brackett and Carol Grindel met with the selectmen regarding property R08-002 that borders Cornish and Parsonsfield. The total acreage is in dispute and they presented their research findings for review and discussion. A motion was made to send the documents to John E. O'Donnell & Associates, Inc. for their input. Seconded and approved. Once the acreage is resolved they would like to request an abatement review of the property's valuation.

Accounts payable and payroll warrants reviewed and approved along with the minutes from the last meeting.

Selectmen signed the Assessor's Return for York and an 801 for Coca Cola of NNE.

Public hearing held for the General Assistance Ordinance Guidelines. Motion made to accept the new guidelines for General Assistance. Seconded and approved.

Letter read from Norm MacIntyre requesting to have an ADA meeting on Wednesday, November 1<sup>st</sup>. Peggi will be out of town and Vinal has a prior commitment and will not be available. Diane will inform Norm he needs contact Barba+Wheelock Architects to reschedule the meeting.

Diann Perkins submitted a request for a guest speaker for the Comprehensive Plan Board with funds from the Planning Board. Diane Harrington informed the selectmen that Dan Sherman has suggested that Diann contact Southern Maine Regional Planning and Maine Municipal Association for information and guidance regarding the subject matter.

Selectmen reviewed a letter of complaint regarding hazardous parking situation at a residence on Main Street. Vinal acknowledged receiving numerous complaints regarding the issue. A motion was made to send a letter to the residents informing them of the safety and accessibility issues involved and request that they take action to correct it. Letter to be copied to the sheriff, the state police and the resident lodging the complaint. Seconded and approved.

Notification received that Greg Wilfert is resigning from the Fairgrounds Committee because he is working on the Planning Board.

Motion made to go into Executive Session to discuss a concealed weapons permit. Approved and seconded.

John Palmer asked if the Town has work in the outlying cemeteries for David Healey to ward off the need to lay him off at the end of the month. Time will be needed to research the work needed and appointment of someone to oversee the work. Vinal stated that it was too short a notice to approve the request.




