MINUTES OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING - October 26, 1987

Present: Warren Neal; Ronald Othuse; Bonita Ouellette

- 1) Two gun permits signed - Linda Keith two votes to 1
Craig Jones two votes to 1.
- 2) Living Water Ministry inquired into renting the Pike Hall for Church services on Sundays. Rent? Would like a flat rate. Motion made and three selectmen in favor of not renting hall. Warren to contact them.
- 3) BEU Copier Contract - Motion made and vote 3 - 0 to renew.
- 4) Ethel Sargent's Wood: Ethel states 5 cords of wood cost of \$500. She will pay \$200 and Town will pay \$300. She does have a document from Eva Lord giving her the wood.
- 5) Sewers: Engineer will meet 11-4 with David Whitney. Put work out to bid.
- 6) David Birchfield: CODE segment of permit fee is abandoned in the above sewer project and \$10 will be the only cost.
- 7) Sidewalks: Bonnie will meet with F. R. Carroll and see how far they can go for \$2,000.
- 8) Water District: National Shawmut payment \$6,938. due. Warren has talked with PUC. Ray Hammond said that at the time the hearings were held in Augusta Paul Frinsco agreed that the District did not have to pay this back. Paul said that the intent was that it was to be town owned, which was not so. It is true that the town purchased the district. Ray Hammond is furious at Frinsco. The PUC will authorize the District to repay Town. PUC wrote Frinsco stating he is to meet with the Selectmen and PuC to clear this up.
- 9) Transfer Station: Basically back where we were. There is a meeting Wed. with Sebago Technics, Sawyers and Delbert Gilpatrick. Should Warren & Bonnie go? Normantus site still seems the best and he has figured large amounts of rubbish whereas BFI is figureing low. Would Normantus sign a contract just with Cornish? Ronnie will talk with him, re price, etc. Interlocal has got to get a decision soon as Normantus will be closing his doors.
- 10) Supplemental Taxes: Motion made that due to errors made on certain taxes customers can still get discount if town was notified before October 14th of the error. VOTE.
- 11) Danny Day would like to have an Alternate appointed to Board of Appeals. Ordinance states 5-member board.
- 12) David submitted letter about Jim Seelye's permit. He was given a list of things to do by the Planning Board and he has not met any of them. Mr. Seelye must go before the Planning Board again.

13) Ronnie asked if Millard Solomon had applied for building permit. He is in the Flood Plain or at least part of house lot is.
