

Selectmen's Meeting October 31, 2012

Vinal Pendexter and Nancy Perkins were present.

Agenda: Allaire Palmer and Jack Bash Warrants and Minutes reviewed and signed.

Bonney Memorial Library purchased the property next to them. They are asking to be reimbursed for the 3 months of real estate taxes paid at closing. Anonymous donors funded the purchase; the purchase did not come out of library funds. The expansion of the library will be funded by Grants and fund raising which will be kept in a separate checking account so that no funds are commingled with the library funds.

Mrs. Palmer and Mr. Bash discussed some potential uses for the building but no definite plans have been made.

Selectmen asked they put their request in a letter to Selectmen. Maine Bureau of Taxation will be contacted for guidelines.

Minutes and Warrants were reviewed and signed.

An 801 for 2011 Personal Property at Heli Modified reviewed and signed.

A Special Educator from CDS Opportunities in Oxford, Maine is looking for a location to use occasionally to do screening of 3-5 year olds for special needs. It would be during the day and only be required when the Porter Town Office is not available. Selectmen declined the request but offered Cornish United Methodist Church as an option.

Cheryl Heavey agreed to put a traffic cone in the parking space in front of the library that is a safety issue to discourage use.

Saco River Corridor Commission informed us the term of town's member on the Board is expiring soon.


The 5 Town Selectmen's meeting changed from November 6th to November 20th. The meeting will start at 6:30 pm at the high school.


Motion made to adjourn the meeting.
