MINUTES OF MEETING _ October 6, 1986

This was agreeable, as this is a charitable organization and monies are returned to Cornish in the way of help to needy children and families.

- 1) Land on Limerick Road sold by Sealed Bids. M. Oulette, \$600. R. Parker, \$300. w. McDade, \$501. R. Provencher, \$400. J. Warren, \$1,200. j. Traunig, \$200. F. Sanborn \$6,000. Land sold to Franklin and Debra Sanborn.
- 2) Salt - Jim to order from Shurtleff, 30 tons.
- 3) Freddie Hayes - Warren checked with State police and they are concerned about Freddie carrying a loaded gun on hip. This has no responsibility with the dog officer.
- 4) Water district: The bonds have been removed from the Fall issue. Will be included in the Spring sale when conditions are met. (Howard, deeds etc.) Bank could loan money to town until Bond Sale in the spring, if they wish to go ahead.
- 5) Ezmund Day - Bob Batchelder to proceed. Trooper told them to clean up per order of the Town. Rabbits being raised to be sold.
- 6) Waste Disposal. Letter from Merc. Jim attended the meeting. Commencement date not established - Feb. 1987 projected. Site under discussion, old Town of Cornish Dump. Jim went to Saco River Corridor Commission and could not get an application. Need Engineer. It takes 120 days to get report from DEP.
- 7) John Jordan wants no parking signs by his house and firebarn because of the traffic at Enterprise. DOT post signs.
- 8) R. Sturgeon - sand on tar on High rd. Several complaints. Sanborn is going to get in touch with him to go over routes to be plowed. Bob offered to put up sand piles, if needed, screening etc.
- 9) Planning Board - sub-committee to set up new zoning ordinance.
- 10) Sidewalks - Church Hill; Holstein sand, sidewalks & sewerage; Cost \$7 per foot, appropriated \$2,000. Basil Day will be contacted, to do the work.
- 11) Eva Lord property - Wilfred has finished survey. Property up for bids. R2-75.
