

Selectmen's Meeting November 22, 2006

Vinal Pendexter, John Palmer, and Peggi Aspinall were present for the meeting.

The Route 113 Corridor Commission study is asking the town of Cornish to be a gateway community. Motion to let the Route 113 Corridor Commission have Cornish as a gateway community for the project. Seconded and approved.

Jeff Fleming, architect representing Sacopee Valley House of Pizza, here to discuss the addition of a drive in window. To accomplish this a new 32-foot wide curb cut would be put in on Old Pike Road along with paving 255 feet of road. St. Saviour will pay for the paving to be done by P Y Estes. Planning Board has already reviewed the application and Bobby Sturgeon has reviewed the plan and asked that a 7 by 40 retention area for run off be included in the plan. Motion by selectmen to agree with the concept of paving and the curb cut but Planning Board will oversee project. Seconded and approved.

Scott Pingree resigned as the EMA director for the Town. Discussion of the demands of the position followed.

A review of the equipment needed to make the PSAP change to State Police in Gray happen found that the Fire department will require a base radio station estimated at \$12-15,000. Funding will hopefully come through a grant that has been applied for and/or if necessary the Fire department dry hydrant account. Motion made to take funds (\$6,000) from surplus for article 22 of the 2006 annual report for matching funds for grants if necessary. Seconded and approved.

Scott informed the selectmen that engine #3 tank has sprung a leak on top and will need to be replaced in the Spring of 2007 through equipment upgrade account.

John Palmer informed the selectmen of a request by Will Call to have the Town Offices moved up to his complex. No discussion.

Warrants for Accounts Payable and Payroll were reviewed and approved. Minutes from prior meeting were read and approved.

Motion made to approve the liquor license for the Sawmill Restaurant. Seconded and approved.

Diane Harrington presented information on single stream recycling. The selectmen decided to table a presentation until January of 2007 at which time Karen from Pine Tree Waste will be here to present a proposal to the board of selectmen.




