

MINUTES SELECTMEN'S MEETING - November 23, 1987

Present: W. Neal, R. Othuse, B. Ouellette

- 1) Elmer Runyon, Esq. was here asking what could be done for Ouellette/Hoyt Subdivision. Warren said they should go back to the Board of Appeals. He asked for copies of minutes of Board of Appeals meeting and copies of appointments of the members of the Board of Appeals and copies of the taped minutes.
- 2) Marilyn McCulloch here in regard to Bonin property. According to law, Patten is to pay the town 10% of the cost of the property - Impact Fee - and they wish to donate a parcel of land to the town. Marilyn is here to find out if the Selectmen prefer the land or cash. Warren feels money in lieu of the land would be feasible. Ronnie is hesitant about accepting the land for liability reasons. Bonnie has no opinion.
- 3) Warren is meeting November 24th at 10 a.m. with Dale Gavin re water district.
- 4) Septic's done: Delbert Harrington, J. Stewart, Maxine Lyle's starts tomorrow.
- 5) Transfer Station: Town of Baldwin not in favor of proposed Normantus site. Two Selectmen said any further action would have to go back to the town. Parsonsfield against site. If we do go back to the Towns, then we should have three articles: 1) Normantus 2) South Hiram 3) Disband. (Interlocal Dump Agreement)
- 5) Moderators light to be purchased for \$40 through Gordon, on sale from \$60.
- 6) Motion to go into Executive Session for 3 gun permits and Auditor's report.
- 7) David has been reading Comprehensive Plan. Asked about changing the zoning on Route 25.
- 8) Pumpkinville needs someone to shovel walks.
- 9) Marilyn McCulloch requests key for front door and to hall. It is the feeling of the Selectmen that to keep keys at a minimum that a key should not be given out. All in favor.
