
A notice was received about a Merc meeting to be held at the Kennebunk Town Hall. The selectmen all plan to attend.


David Whitney's snowplow contract needs to be redone to eliminate Freeman Howard's name. He will be invited to the next meeting to sign it.


A payment was made to Mercy Care to cover Ken Ridsdale's dog bite. Carol was instructed to send the bill to Lovejoy Insurance Agency.
