Vinal Pendexter, Peggi Aspinall, and Nancy Perkins were present for the meeting.

Minutes, accounts payable and payroll warrants signed.

Motion made to approve Cassie Dove's request to reserve Pike Hall to hold a fundraiser for the Middle School trip to Washington DC with a \$100.00 charge for heat. Seconded and approved.

Motion made to approve Peggy McKenzie's use of Fire Barn for Girl Scout meetings. Seconded and approved.

Motion made to wait for Heli Modified, Inc. to approach the Town again to discuss renegotiation of rent. Seconded and approved.

Selectmen agreed to allow the Cornish PTC to utilize the lower level (in addition to the main floor) of Pike Hall for their craft fair.

Motion made to ask Greg Wilfert to attend the next meeting to clarify the Sewer District invoicing groups for use of the public restrooms at the Odd Fellows Hall when using Thompson Park. Seconded and approved.

Nancy requested mileage reimbursement for her trips to Sanford, Maine. Motion made to approve her request. Seconded and approved.

Selectmen discussed two complaints regarding David Whitney's approach in addressing issues with townspeople. It was decided to send a letter to David stating the selectmen's procedure to follow when an issue arises that needs addressing. Nancy offered to draft the letter.


Nancy and Peggi will be attending a Maine Municipal Association Elected Officials workshop on December 4th from 4:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.
