Regular meeting - two members present, Pike & Outhuse

Chairman explained the procedure which will be followed this year in order to obtain Federal Revenue Sharing funds.

Nancy Perkins & Mary Taylor present and Nancy explained the Bicentennial project at the park where an underground wire will be put in to light the tree for Christmas and one to shine on the water fountain.

Discussion on the tree stump at the Auto Parts place - Chairman stated the State had not at the present time been willing to assume responsibility for having it removed. Stump is back 30 feet from road and otherwise responsibility should be the Masonic Lodge.

Voted to request information from the Southern Maine Planning Comm. on parking regulations and penalties for infractions - Special article to be taken up at Town Meeting.

Voted to have David Elliott remove six dead elm trees on road-Back side of Towle's Hill - at rate of \$10.00 per tree. \$50.00 if possible.

Request of David Elliott to cut timber at the old dump refused.

Carroll Contractor Co. estimated that the sidewalk project would probably run over the appropriation by \$300 or \$400.
