

MINUTES OF SELECTMENS MEETING - November 9, 1987

- 1) Is water off at Firemen's Hall? Check with Henry Johnson.
- 2) Telephone Pioneers of America would spend \$300 for Cornish children who are needy. Warren will meet with Fritz Day of the organization on Friday. He will also check with Maggie Hoxie for list of children who could use help for Christmas.
- 3) Sewers: D. Whitney has given a verbal o.k. and he will do all five systems.
- 4) Gary Braley here re Living Waters Ministry renting, leasing or purchasing the Firemen's Hall to hold services in. Selectmen do not think it a very good idea, there are several restrictions. Parking major problem. Renting would pose a liability problem to the town. Purchasing would require a Town Meeting to get citizens approval. Mr. Braley was given the names of a few other places and people to contact.
- 5) Auditor is doing books. He has a question about the \$8,000 voted on 10-27-86 for Solid Waste. Was the intent for it to be raised and appropriated or taken from surplus. Surplus was the intent.
- 6) Transfer Station: Basically the same! Ronnie feels we should go with Normantus. Sebago Technics still working on Gilpatrick site.
- 7) Water District: Warren read copy of letter from PUC to Frinsko.
- 8) Sidewalks: Done - front of hotel, lyle's and Bettencourt's.
- 9) Annual Sales Analysis ratio, must be completed and returned to State. 70% ratio. Warren to fill it out.
- 10) Drama club is going to use hall 6:30 to 9 and 2:30 to 3:30 on November 19th.
- 11) Planning Board is going to meet the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of the month. Work sessions must be posted and be an open meeting.
- 12) Brownies want to use Town Hall 11-23 7-8 for a ceremony. Seconded VOTE.
- 13) An Evangelistic Service would like to hold meetings for three weeks, three nights a week after January 1st. Motion to deny Seconded VOTE 3-0 against.
- 14) David wants to run his AD for another two weeks. He asked the Selectmen for guidelines on Performance Standards re gravel pits. Map needs to be submitted to P.B. showing where the earth is being removed.
- 15) Gordon asked about heat upstairs. Reports back door broken into two times. Advised to repair with hasp on inside.
- 16) Cornish Dump: Report of some pickup truck coming out of old dump. People are using it as a dump site. There are papers dating back to 1966 to a R. Morrison. Selectmen feel there should be a chain across entrance.

17) Motion made to Adjourn regular meeting and go into Executive Session to hear general assistance case and gun permit.
