Selectmen's Meeting  
December 11, 1979

Present: Hoxie, Ronnie, Doctor DiBiasco, Marcia

- 1.) Doc regarding Eva Lord: Eva has been moved into a boarding home in Limerick, and the question rose as to what to do with her State checks. It was decided to turn them over to Charlene until Ronnie finds out more as to the usual procedure. The Doctor also suggested that an inventory be taken of the contents of Eva's house incase of a break in, and that new locks be put on and the house be completely closed up. Doc is to see Eva the next time he's in Limerick and ask her if she would like the town to take responsibility of the house, keys, inventory, etc. There is also the coal to be recovered and returned for credit
- 2.) The Mormons will be out of the Town Hall by the end of December.
- 3.) A meeting date of Dec. 20th has been set for the Dep't. of Transportation Public Hearing on the Rt. 5 project. Meeting will be held at 7:00 P.M. at the Pike Hall. Doc raised the issue of whether the DOT should pay for the use of the hall. Marcia to get an add to the Shopper's Guide
- 4.) Street light to go at the end of the Ft. 5 construction. It's to be a 175 Watt mercury vapor. Ronnie or Hoxie to get a pole no. and Marcia to notify CMP
5. Saco River Corridor/Carl Laws requests that the Selectmen write to the county commissioners supporting their(SCC) budget request to be granted. Carl's budget was \$10,000 last year and has increased to \$12,000 this year, but the county comm. had cut his budget to \$6,000. Non of the Selectmen felt qualified to make any such kind of recommendation, therefor, request was denied to Carl.
- 6.) Hoxie spoke with Walt Stickney in regards to the replacement of two comm. members and Walt suggested that the comm. consist of both active and non-active members. It is felt that is a lot to require a member to attend every meeting. It was decided that the comm. will consist of 7-9 active and inactive members and that Don White and Chris Birchfield be added to the list of comm. members. Bill also suggested leaving Howard Saturley and Nan Sawyer on the list as inactive members.
- 7.) It was decided that the Selectmen sign two extra warrant pages tonight and that Marcia will get the warrant to Charlene, without any meeting previous, on the 26th or the 27th. If there is any question Hoxie will be home wed. for consultation if necessary.
