

Selectmen's Meeting December 15, 2000

Meeting was called to order at 7:00.

Ron Othuse came in to discuss Life and Disability insurance for the firemen. He will work it in the Fire Company's budget. Vinal will take the policy and get it checked out.

The minutes from the 11/29/00 meeting were signed. The payroll warrants were signed. The accounts payable needed a correction on the WL Sturgeon payment and that was signed. The correction was made and the revised check was sent out 12/15/00. The selectmen also signed the pole permits.

There was a discussion about George Carroll's tax abatement from 1997, and a request of the selectmen's meeting tape of 10/18 and 11/15. It was decided that he could have the transcribed minutes.

Maine Equilation Consultants, Inc. sent back a revised proposal for the town reevaluation. The price was higher than the original proposal. The selectmen discussed doing an in-house reevaluation instead of hiring out at this time.

Cornish Historical Society made a request that the floor be sanded and refinished in the room they are using in Pike Hall. Since it is used for storage and the town is paying for the heat they don't feel it is necessary for now.

It was decided to send Frank Smith a card and a fruit basket after his surgery for recognition of all his work with the Historical Society.


A time needs to be set up to give Elsie Troutman the oldest citizen cane. Carlton will get the cane cleaned, and see if they can set up a mutually advantageous date.


Carlton and John are going to find someone to clean the Town Hall.
