

Selectmen's Meeting December 15, 2010

Vinal Pendexter, Margaret Aspinall, and Nancy Perkins were present.

Warrants and minutes reviewed and signed.

Septage disposal permits were the topic of discussion. Vinal will review the permitting process and talk with pumping contractors servicing in our area.

Mike Morse's reply to our email was the topic of discussion. The "date" he's referring to is the enactment date of the Cornish Shoreland Zoning Ordinance. Vinal will attend the Planning Board Workshop and inform Dan Sherman the Planning Board is responsible to research Town records of Public Meeting minutes for the correct enactment date.

Requests for proposal from Steve Sanborn, O'Donnell, J. T. Lockwood for shoreland mapping were reviewed and discussed. Motion made to invite Mike O'Donnell to a selectman's meeting to present a short overview of O'Donnell's mapping options. Seconded and approved.

Results from the survey of surrounding towns' employee benefits were presented to selectmen. Selectmen asked for copies of the results to review.

Motion made to start the process on the ADA Project for Pike Memorial Hall by authorizing Nancy Barba to start the second phase (\$5,000). Selectmen will do their part by setting up an energy audit. Selectmen agreed to ask Jack Bash for a contractor reference that performs energy audits. Mike Jenkins to be notified by email that we have started the second phase with Nancy Barba. Seconded and approved.

Nancy asked that the General Assistance work she is doing be distributed more evenly among the selectmen. She asked Vinal and Peggi for suggestions.

The selectmen reviewed and signed the United States Census Bureau Boundary and Annexation Survey sent from the United States Department of Commerce.

Vinal reviewed the fee schedule with the code enforcement officer and will make the suggested changes to update the fee schedule. It is targeted to be ready for January 31st so it can be effective for FY2011. Diane asked if the planning board fees were included in the fee schedule and they are not.




