Selectmen discussed a draft letter to implement a parking ban around Thompson Park during and after snowstorm to make clean up easier. Vinal was sure that an Ordinance is required before selectmen have the power to enforce a parking ban. Elaine will contact MMA Legal for their interpretation.


Les MacMaster resigned from the Planning Board. Selectmen asked to run an ad for a replacement Member on the Board.


