

Selectmen's Meeting December 2, 2009

Vinal Pendexter, Peggi Aspinall and Nancy Perkins were present for the meeting.

Harry and Cindy Eddy report they have not been successful in securing a line of credit for Heli Modified, Inc. The decision was made to meet with them at 2-week intervals for a status report. Cindy Eddy asked for details regarding a bail out of Accessories Unlimited in 1998 that was handled through the CBDG program. The selectmen suggested they contact John Cleveland who handled the details. If unable to contact Mr. Cleveland the Town will research it for the meeting on 12/16. Motion made to write a letter stating the status of Heli and their relationship with the Town. Seconded and approved.

Warrants and minutes reviewed and signed.

Selectmen signed a letter for Cliff and Debra Walker regarding their abatement request.

Three (3) abatements; 2 for KLP, LLC and 1 for Mr. & Mrs. Walker and (1) Supplemental for KLP, LLC were signed.

An 801 for Wells Fargo was signed.

The Town has not been billed for 3 years of transporting recycling containers to ecomaine to be emptied and returned. Selectmen asked that a letter be sent to Mr. Herrick requesting he meet with them in January, either the 13th or 27th meeting. The letter must be sent certified mail with return receipt.

Peggi Aspinall reports that the 5 Year Plan Committee is finalizing reports and will present to the SAD#55 School Board in January.

A selectman and the town's EMA Director need to set a date for training on the NIMS computer application at the EMA office in Alfred. Peggi offered to represent the selectmen and will coordinate with Mark Mayhew.

Scott Pingree will attend the meeting on Wednesday, December 9th regarding cleaning of the Fire Station.

Late Night Lettering is to provide a quote for the 'CORNISH RESIDENTS ONLY' lettering for the sign at the sand/salt shed.


DOT responded to correspondence from Nancy Perkins regarding a property owner's attempts to control access to the right of way to the tower. DOT offered the services of John Poor, Manager Transportation Investigations, to visit Cornish and view the DOT's property on Hessian Hill.
