Regular meeting of selectmen, all members present.

Discussion of parking problem in town. Voted to see if Selectmen could be granted power to restrict parking on streets on a temporary basis until ordinances are drawn up by the town and also have power to invoke violations for same.

Federal Revenue to continue for three years under the same procedure as formally for town the size of Cornish.

Received Anti-recession payment of \$570.00 for two payments. Two more payments through Sept. 1977. Special Town Meeting to spend April and July payment.

Snow Removal contract due to be renewed in 1977.

Discussion of new rules and regulations for discontinuing roads.

TRI money needs to be spent on road from Alton Loud's house to Bobby Scott's.

Two members of the Kiwanis Club were present and discussed the possibility of using the basement of the Town Hall to hold their meetings. Selectmen will consider it and make decision at a later date.
