

Selectmen's Meeting December 6, 2006

Vinal Pendexter, John Palmer, and Peggi Aspinall were present for the meeting.

Beth Phelps requested the selectmen's approval to represent the Town of Cornish on the Saco River Corridor Commission. Motion to let her represent the town on the Saco River Corridor Commission. Seconded and approved.

Selectmen reviewed an invoice submitted by David Brandt for legal services for the town between 10/12/05 through 05/01/06. Motion to approve the invoice of \$200 from David Brandt. Seconded and approved.

Revisited the proposal for signs submitted by Lori Carr. It was decided to make four (4) 36" x 48" signs in ivory with black lettering and a maroon border. Selectmen asked that Lori Carr attend a future meeting and bring a color palette and sample of post options for mounting the signs. Motion made to accept the color, size and number of signs for the town. Seconded and approved.

Vinal informed the other selectmen of a phone conversation he had with Mr. Piccininni regarding the abatement he submitted to the town. Mr. Piccininni was assured by Vinal that his specific questions on the valuation process would be addressed in the near future.

Peggi suggested Nancy Perkins or Emily Ward to fill the position of EMA Coordinator for the town. Diane will place an advertisement in the Shopping Guide.

Vinal proposed an increase in the stipends for Fire Chief and other department volunteers as their responsibilities have increased greatly.

Motion made to go into executive session to discuss personnel issues. Resume regular selectmen's meeting. Seconded and approved.

Warrants for Payroll and Accounts Payable were reviewed and approved. Vinal questioned the amount of mileage submitted by the ACO for round trip to Harvest Hills in Fryeberg. The CAB invoice for \$1000 for excavation work will be taken from the Thompson Park Improvements account. Minutes were read and approved.

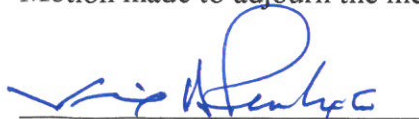

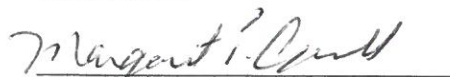
