

MINUTES SELECTMEN'S MEETING - FEBRUARY 10, 1992

PRESENT; WARREN NEAL, VINAL PENDEXTER, CARLTON CANDAGE

1. GEORGE HENTSCHEL HERE REGARDING HIS PROPERTY TAXES AND VALUATION. SELECTMEN EXPLAINED EACH LOT TO HIM.

2. GENTLEMEN HERE ASKING IF THEY COULD PROVIDE THE TOWN HALL WITH A 4 X 6 MAT TO BE USED BY THE FRONT DOOR TO CATCH THE SAND. THE COST WOULD BE \$6.00 BY-WEEKLY.

MOTION MADE AND SECONDED TO ALLOW THIS PERSON TO PUT MAT DOWN AND IF IT DOES NOT WORK OUT - NO THANKS. VOTE 3-0.

8. TOWN REPORT BIDS: LINCOLN PRESS - NO MONEY QUOTED. RISING RIVER GRAPHICS \$876. ROSE DESIGNS \$1297. LAURA CARR \$985. MOTION MADE AND SECONDED TO AWARD THE CONTRACT FOR THE PRINTING OF THE TOWN REPORT TO RISING RIVER GRAPHICS. VOTE 3-0. ALL BIDDERS HAVE BEEN NOTIFIED 2/11/92.
