

**SELECTMEN'S MEETING  
FEBRUARY 18, 2004**

Diann will let them know that this is an old building without a security system or sprinklers. The selectmen will discuss this and get back to her, as it is a long time to tie up the town hall.

Carol mentioned that she had received a call about renting the gazebo for a wedding. She had called Mr. Lovejoy asking if the Town was covered with insurance for this rental. He had suggested that the renter have a certificate of insurance from their homeowners policy, but the Town is covered. Carol was instructed to talk to them about lack of parking, but they can rent it with a charge of \$50.00.


Carol also brought up that she had been asked if the Cornish Sanitary Sewer District could list delinquent payers in the town report. Vinal said that he could write his report listing them.
