

MINUTES SELECTMEN'S MEETING - February 20, 1989

Present: W. Neal, R. Othuse, T. Carper

- 1) Meeting called to order at 8 p.m.
- 2) M. McCulloch: re Comp. Plan, 7:30 p.m. meeting on March 1st. This is to be a combined meeting of the 10 committees, Steering Committee and Selectmen and Southern Maine Regional Planning. Of the 10 committees, three are to meet on same night in order to enable Marilyn to attend these meetings. Notify Charlene when meetings will take place, so hall will be open. The Steering Committee will meet on Monday, February 27th and interview 4-5 private concerns. Marilyn has asked for a key to the hall and office so she can get in when the machines are not being used. Tom feels we should put this off for several weeks until we see about how much room we have with this expansion. Ronnie feels that if we hand a key out to Marilyn, the next person down the line would want another key. Warren suggested that Marilyn call when she wanted to get in the office and someone would let her in.
- 3) Sign Ordinance must be posted at least 30 days, not up to 30 days prior to Town Meeting, so will have to wait until next special town meeting.
- 4) Flood Plain Management Hearing 8 p.m. March 6th. This must be posted. Marilyn will take care of this. (Article also for Town Meeting.)
- 5) Bob Bowker 's report is in. Ken Libby and Bob Bowker state that there is federal money available. (Program is expensive)
- 6) Tuesday 10 a.m. people are coming to look at clock in Odd Fellows Hall.
- 7) Must notify Mickey that we need Fire Department Report for Town Report.
- 8) Selectmen have gone over articles for the Town Report.
- 9) Should Town notify Parsonsfield re David Jordan's proposal for door-door pickup of Solid Waste. Warren will call Liz Dudley.
- 10) Diann Perkins re Town Meeting: She suggests video taping the whole meeting. All Department Heads should sit down front with Selectmen. All non-residents and teenagers should be seated in balcony. Bill Hoxie (Moderator) will make the announcement of the last request. The rest will be ignored!
- (11) Diann Perkins called Marilyn and asked that all three Selectmen should be at Planning Board Meeting to explain their action on the Killdeer Acre problem.
