MINUTES OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING - February 24, 1986

Present: Donald Jack, Dr. DiBiaso, John Seelye

1) Addition of Article 55 - Amending the Town Charter, the right to revoke anyone not performing correctly. Don will write Secretary of State to see if the Town does in fact have a Charter

Article 56 - Waive rental fee for tax exempt organizations. Don will check will of Pike. Believe, it reads, for the use of Cornish churches and schools, this is supposedly in Will.

Article 57 - Eligibility of Manager of Cornish Water Co. and Directors. There is an article in Water Co. bill stating no Selectmen or Road Commissioner can be a Director. As a Water District, it encompasses the entire Town and anyone from any part of Town can run for Officer or Director. Hearing is March 4th. LCD 2002.

2) Florence Weeks. Re her taxes. Don spoke with her and explained how not paying the small amount due on her taxes would cloud her title if she ever should want to sell the property.

3) John Smith, Plumbing Inspector, wants to know when Planning Board meets.
