- 1) Letter read from PUC regarding Cornish Water District to repay monies paid by the town.
- 2) Letter received from D.O.T. giving town 30 days to close bridge #1289 or put up sign - Weight Limit 3 tons.
MOTION MADE AND SECONDED THAT WEIGHT LIMIT SIGNS BE POSTED. VOTE.

- 3) Three people have expressed interest in serving on the Planning Board as an alternate. MOTION MADE AND SECONDED THAT JUDY MATHESON BE APPOINTED AN ASSOCIATE MEMBER. AMENDED: FOR A ONE YEAR TERM.
- 4) Retirement Plan: Town must vote to go on S.S. or Maine State Retirement Fund. MOTION MADE AND SECONDED THAT WE ADD TO THE WARRANT TO MODIFY THE SS. TO COVER ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN.

The State Police called Ronnie to inform him that the road on Tomb Hill had to be sanded. Franklin could not be contacted, so Ronnie called Harold Bucknell who sanded the hill.
