Mr. + Mrs. Gurley put in a request for an abatement on the taxes paid for the year 2000 due to the building being condemned. The selectmen will have to have more information.

Pat Junkins requested a letter stating that the road behind his property has been abandoned or discontinued.

The Annual report from the State Police Troop A. was received.

Carlton didn't have the correct telephone number to get in touch with Peter Ouelette to come in and talk about the opening on the planning board. Since then Dan Carubia and Peter Simard have also submitted applications. They will all be invited to a meeting.

George Carroll's tax abatement was discussed. The information that Mike Rogers gave Vinal on Mr. Carroll's application was false. The selectmen have decided to ignore his application for the last three years because of late filing and the information on his application. They will accept it for the 2001 tax year. Vinal will call Mr. Rogers to make sure this is correct.

Carlton wants to mail out the Town Reports. It will cost \$607.00 for postage. Vinal wants a rough draft to look at before it is sent to the printer.
